This has been a year of great blessing in Kandhamal, India, thanks in great part to the faithful and generous supporters of GPMO.



Many improvements were made on the Nanda campus. Bathrooms were upgraded. Repairs were made in the kitchen. The boys' dorm was moved to a larger space, and the roof was replaced to protect the boys from the rain and cold.

A magnificent water tower was built that now supplies all the water needs on campus- in the kitchen, guest houses, staff houses, children's bathrooms, and for doing laundry.

GPMO was able to help two of the tribal congregations that were affected by persecution to rebuild their churches. A new roof was put on

the Kanjemenmdi Church, and the Borikia congregation dedicated their new church on Christmas Day.



As children come from the Kutia Kondha tribe in Belghar to live and be educated at Nanda, they are returning to tell their families and friends about Jesus. This formerly unreached people group is becoming more open to the Gospel, and a new church has opened in Belghar!



Saima and Hemant were able to spend several weeks in India at the end of the year, after which Hemant had the opportunity to go on to meet with Christians in Nepal and Dubai. Nine of the Nanda children graduated from high school. The 4 or 5 children who received top grades will have the opportunity to go on to higher education paid by the government. Two students are currently in



nursing school, thanks to your support through the scholarship fund. Another student graduated from nursing school and is working in Bhubaneshwar, the capital of Orissa. The children are doing well and benefitting from more regular medical care. With limited medical care available in the community, we grieve that even a gift to provide extra ongoing care could not save Pilata, a child who was dealing with very serious health problems.
